

IMPORTANT DELEGATE SELECTION INFORMATION

Hello, I hope this clears any confusion about the delegate selection process for District NYI Convention 2010.

NYI Convention will be held at College Church of the Nazarene in Nampa, ID on March 12, 2010 from 7-9:30pm. All delegates are required to be members in their local churches.

You don't have to be a delegate to attend District NYI Convention. There will be a special area marked reserved just for the delegates. Anyone can attend, and I encourage that non-delegates attend. There will be areas where non-delegates can sit and watch as reports are given. Delegates are required to be members of your local church.

The number of delegates you can have is determined by the following example:

1) Look in the 2009 Intermountain District Assembly Journal (green) on page 83. Locate your church name and look under column 21 and this will tell you what your church reported as the number of NYI members. (The members are not necessarily members of the Nazarene church; they are the number of teens in your ministry responsibility list.)

2) Then look in the 2005-2009 Manual on page 286 at the bottom to determine how many delegates you can bring. (2001-2005 Manual page 296)

For example: Canyon Hill had 70 members of NYI on page 83 in the 2009 Intermountain District Assembly Journal. Then, by looking at the 2005-2009 Manual on page 286 at the bottom I determined that Canyon Hill can bring 5 delegates.

Delegates must register in advance by March 1, 2010. Each church must submit their list of delegates to the District NYI Secretary, Rev. Jennifer Vasquez.
